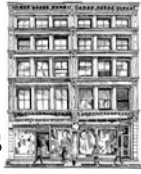

Finished quilt size: 40" x 46"

Fabric Requirements

1 yard Farm-C7113 Cream
1/4 yard Farm-C7114 Coral
1/4 yard Farm-C7115 Grey
1/4 yard Farm-C7116 Brown
1/4 yard Farm-C7117 Green
1/4 yard Spin-C5300 Surf
1/3 yard Spin-C5300 Coral
1/2 yard Spring-C5300 Spring
5/8 yard Spin-C5300 Brown
(includes 3/8 yard for binding)
1 1/3 yards Farm-C7118 Multi
2 2/3 yards backing of your choice
48" x 54" batting

Cutting

From Farm-C7113 Cream:

- Cut one 22 1/2" x 28 1/2" length-of-fabric (LOF) rectangle.

From both Farm-C7114 Coral and Farm-C7115 Grey:

- Cut one 3 1/2" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut five 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

From Farm-C7116 Brown:

- Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

From Farm-C7117 Green:

- Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
- Cut four 3 1/4" squares.

From Spin-C5300 Surf:

- Cut four 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

From Spin-C5300 Coral:

- Cut five 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

From Spin-C5300 Spring:

- Cut four 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty 3 1/2" squares.

From Spin-C5300 Brown:

- Cut four 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut two 1 1/2" x 28 1/2" and two 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" strips.
- Cut five 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From Farm-C7118 Multi:

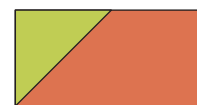
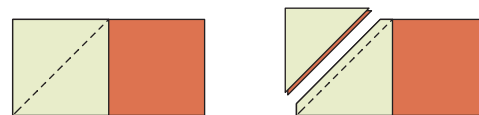
- Referring to the quilt photo for motif placement, fussy-cut four 3 1/4" x LOF strips.

Quilt Top Assembly

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right sides together.

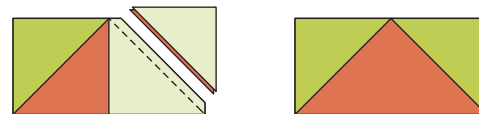
1. Sew one 1 1/2" x 28 1/2" C5300 Brown strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 28 1/2" C7113 Cream rectangle.
2. Sew one 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" C5300 Brown strip to the top and another to the bottom of the C7113 Cream rectangle.
3. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of thirty-six 3 1/2" C5300 Spring squares.
4. Following Figure 1 for line direction, place a 3 1/2" C5300 Spring square on the left edge of a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" C7114 Coral rectangle. Sew on the marked line and trim the excess corner fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Open the triangle and press it toward the corner.

5. Following Figure 2 for line direction, place a 3 1/2" C5300 Spring square on the right edge of the step 4 rectangle. Sew on the marked line and trim the excess corner fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Open the triangle and press it toward the corner.

6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 to make a total of five C7114 Coral and C7115 Grey flying-geese blocks and four each of C7116 Brown and C7117 Green.



7. Referring to the quilt photo for placement and orientation, lay out the flying-geese blocks around the bordered quilt center. Sew five 3¹/₂" x 6¹/₂" flying-geese blocks together for each side border. Noting the orientation, sew each pieced border to its respective side.
8. For the top and bottom borders, sew together four 3¹/₂" x 6¹/₂" flying-geese blocks. Sew a 3¹/₂" C5300 Spring square to each end of each row. Noting the orientation, sew one pieced row to the top and the other bottom of the center.
9. Measure the quilt center length and cut two 1¹/₂" C5300 Surf strips that measurement. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
10. Measure the quilt center width and using the remaining 1¹/₂" C5300 Surf strips, cut two that measurement. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom.
11. Referring to the quilt photo for orientation, sew one 3¹/₄" x LOF C7118 Multi strip to each side of the quilt. Trim the excess strip length.
12. Trim the remaining two 3¹/₄" x LOF C7118 Multi strips to the same length as the step 10 C5300 Surf strip. Sew a 3¹/₄" C7117 Green square to each end of both strips. Matching adjacent seams, sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom.
13. Sew the five 1¹/₂" C5300 Coral strips together end to end. Repeat steps 9 and 10 using 1¹/₂" C5300 Coral strips for the outside border.

Finishing

14. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
15. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
16. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
