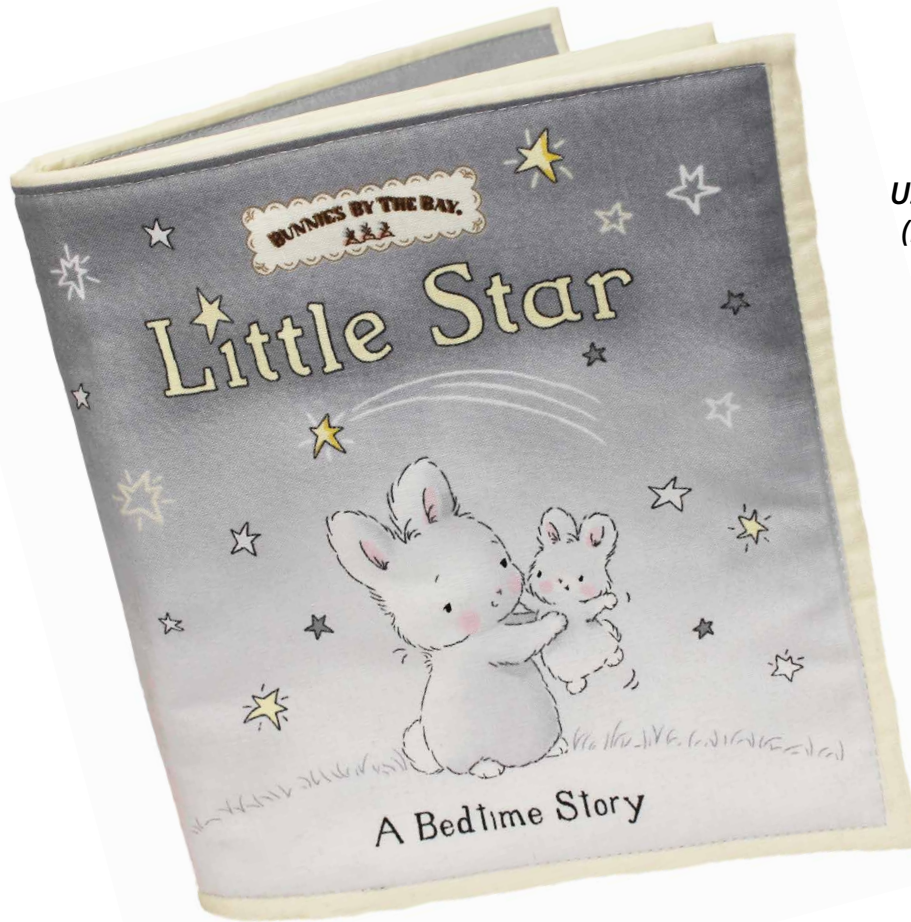

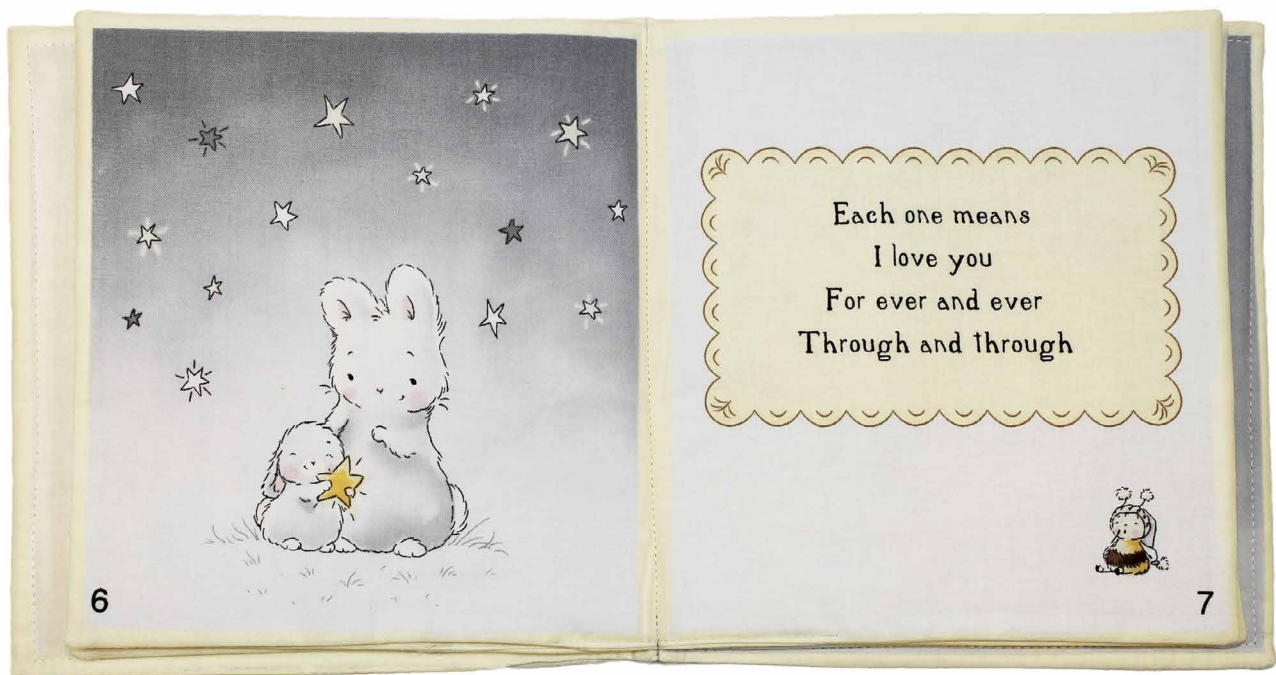

Use the 36" Little Star Book Panel (Bunnies-C6448 Yellow) to make this soft book, which measures approximately 8 1/4" square. Instructions are printed directly onto the panel.



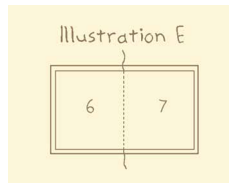
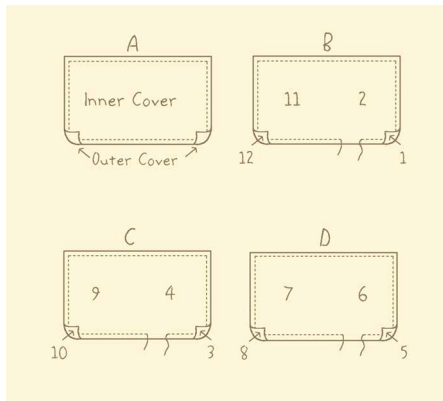


Fabric Requirements & Kitting Chart

Fabric	Yardage for 1 Book	Bolts for 12 Books	Bolts for 24 Books	Bolts for 36 Books
Bunnies-C6448 Yellow	1	1	2	3

Total yardage for 1 book: 1

You will also need scraps of low-loft batting for the book pages.

36" Book Panel (Bunnies-C6448 Yellow)

How to make a Soft Book

Cut all double pages along the grey dotted cutting line.
Please note: The book cover pages are a little larger than the rest of the book pages.
1/4 " seam allowance is included on all pages.

Cut 1 piece of low loft batting to match the size of the cover page and 3 pieces to match the inside book pages.

With right sides together, place as follows:
Outer Cover with Inner Cover
Pages 12 and 1 with pages 2 and 11
Pages 10 and 3 with pages 4 and 9
Pages 8 and 5 with 6 and 7
See Illustrations A, B, C and D above

Place each pair, still right sides together on top of a corresponding batting rectangle and pin around all sides. Stitch around the edges with a 1/4" seam allowance, leaving a 2-3" opening at the bottom for turning.

Clip corners to reduce bulk and trim away as much of the batting from the seam allowance as possible.

Turn all sections right side out, gently poke out corners and press edges flat. Slipstitch or topstitch with matching thread to close all the openings.

Fold and press the center page section in half to mark a vertical line between pages 6 and 7.

Center and stack the pages on a flat surface. Start with the Outer cover of the book facing down, then pages 2/11 facing up, followed by pages 4/9 and 6/7. Check the page order to be sure everything is in its proper sequence. Pin or clip the stack to hold in place and carefully stitch down the center crease through all the pages.

Bolt estimates are based on a standard 15-yard bolt.
